July 12, 2019, by noon	Case briefs due from all parties arguing that continued or resumed dumping is likely or not likely
July 26, 2019, by noon	Reply submissions due from all parties in respect of the case briefs
October 4, 2019	CBSA's determination If decision is affirmative, information pursuant to the Canadian International Trade Tribunal Rules is transferred to the CITT
October 18, 2019	Statement of Reasons issued
